LESSONS COVERED: ULAT 2.6

CONTENT:

1. PHONICS 4

OVERVIEW: Lesson 2.6 involves learning the language's phonics system with particular emphasis given to a fourth vowel. The first four vowels studied are highlighted in the readings found in lesson 2.6 – either regarding the Richardson family, the Creation account in Genesis or both.

ACTIVITIES:

1. Have students work on both numbers and the alphabet by **dictating their street address**, spelling the name of their street, while classmates copy down the address. Write the address on the board so that they can check their understanding.
2. **READ** with the students through the entire lesson 2.6 however, when you come to the actual reading selection in section 6, do NOT ask the students to read it aloud. First, point to the highlighted syllables in each sentence and have the students try to produce their sound. Then either click on the mouse to play the entire sentence for them or read it to them yourself. Click on [PHONICS INSTRUCTION](#) for further explanation.
3. Have the students engage in [INDEPENDENT STUDY](#) and direct them to review the reading in part 6.
4. Perform the [ORAL PARTICIPATION](#) activity found at the end of lesson 2.6. You can either have the students retell the story from the images found there, or tell it to them yourself, inserting errors that the students must catch, or make a statement about one of the images for which the students must form a question that would receive that statement as its answer.
