DAY 98

LESSONS COVERED: ULAT 2.15

CONTENT:

1. LEARNING TO EXPRESS TIME AND ONE'S DAILY ROUTINE

OVERVIEW: In lesson 2.15, the students are first taught to express the time of day. Next, involving many of the newly learned daily routine verbs, a man's daily activities are placed in chronological order and the students learn to join the elements of daily routine activities and the expression of time in order to describe one's daily routine.

ACTIVITIES:

- 1. If you lacked sufficient time in the last class, conduct an **ORAL PARTICIPATION** session over the **INTERACTION SEQUENCE** in section 4 of lesson 2.14.
- 2. Do a **REVIEW SEQUENCE** with the daily routine verbs and gestures learned in lesson 2.11.
- 3. Do a **DRILLING SEQUENCE** over sections 1 and 2 of lesson 2.15.
 - a. **READ** with the students through these sections of the lesson.
 - b. Give the students time for **INDEPENDENT STUDY**.
 - c. Do a **PAIRED READING** over these sections
 - d. Have the students engage in **ORAL PARTICIPATION** over the items in section 2.
